Course Description:

After finishing the first Khmer Language Course Part I, students have built the foundation in adapting to Khmer language in term of the characteristics of the language and other basic foundations related to listening and speaking skills. Nonetheless, learning has no limitation. Having known the basic, it is fundamental to continue building up the knowledge of Khmer Language. Because of this, the Khmer Language Course Part II is coming to serve the purpose of stepping up from beginner level to elementary level.

With this Khmer Language Course Part II, students will be taught more component of Khmer Language. There will be five lessons, which each of them equip with words, grammar, and conversation. Continuing from Part I, the course is based on "Cambodian for Beginners" (2nd edition) by Richard K. Gilbert. You will be studying under the guidance of the Khmer teacher who will help students speak Khmer better and more fluent. The approach of teaching is based upon Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) or Communicative Approach.

Course Objectives:

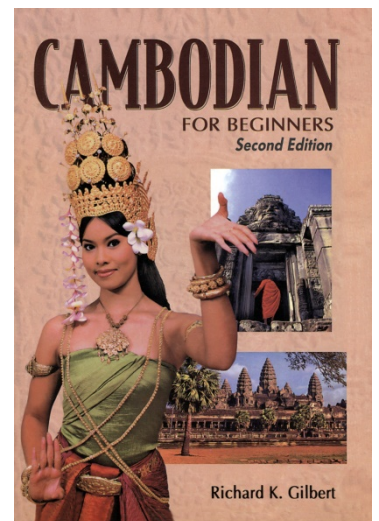
This Khmer Language Course Part II is aimed to:


