Course Description:

This course is designed for expat students who would like to be able to make basic conversation in a short period of time. It focuses on developing students' speaking and listening skills. This course comprises two parts- part1 and 2; each part takes 15 hours.

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The 1st part, a fundamental or preparation phase for beginners, has been started with simple rules of Khmer language followed by some basically conversational lessons. According to our students who took the 1st part, now they have been able to produce basic sentences and learn new vocabulary themselves when doing self-study.

In this 2nd part, learners' conversational skill will be developed further through various topics; they will expand their vocabulary and be able to produce more sentences from English to Khmer. To enable our learners to develop their conversational skill within a short period of time, we have created authentic materials by developing daily-life based lessons. The students also learn different tips to understanding and speaking Khmer quickly from our teachers.

In addition to conversational skill development, in each lesson, the students will be exposed to Cambodian culture as well, which is a very important thing for foreigners when they live in foreign countries.

Course Objectives for Beginner I:

After completing Listening Speaking for Beginner I, students will be basically able to greet people and ask and tell about prices, number, direction and positions of objects. Also, they'll be able to talk about their family and future plan.

Methods:

Students will be exposed to topics of daily-life situations. During lecture, they will be taught how to communicate in two ways- formal and non-formal. They will be asked to work in pair or group when discussing. Other activities will also be applied according to the teacher's judgment on their students' learning styles.

Assessment methods:

There is no examination for this course. Students will be mainly assessed on their listening, speaking and pronunciation through tasks and homework assigned by the teacher.

Materials:

Our course is not text book based. Thus, we do not use any text book, but we use lesson handouts, which are developed by ourselves, to teach our students. Of course, the handouts are free for the students.

Session 1-2	Lesson 1: Greetings	Students will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none">- greet and welcome people in Khmer in both formal and informal contexts.- introduce themselves.	2
Session 3-4	Lesson 2: My classroom	Students will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none">- ask and answer basic questions about objects, for example, what and where they are, what their colors are, and how many things there are- describe their classroom	2
Session 5-6	Lesson 3: At the clothes shop	Students will be able to ask about what they need when they are at the clothes shop, for example, asking about items, prices, discount, colors, sizes and changing room.	2
Session 7-8	Lesson 4: Number and Counting	Ask and tell about number of things, hours and people.	2
Session 9-10	Lesson 5: Talking about family	Students will be able to describe their family members, for example, their appearance, personality and jobs.	2
Session 11-12	Lesson 6: Asking about direction	Students will be able to ask and tell about direction when they want to go somewhere.	2
Session 13-14	Lesson 7: Talking about future plan	Students will be able to ask and describe what they want to do in the future.	2
Session 15	Revision	Students' doubts about previous lessons will be cleared	1
